GPG update:

BERRYBANK 1 UPDATE

- Availability is now 99%
- Vestas have completed the 2 yearly service on all 43 turbines 35 up from last meeting.
- Luke expanded on what a 2 year service involves.
- Landscape Screening Program 53 properties within the 4kms almost all have received application packages, some cannot be contacted. We have received a number of them back.
- A Landscape architect has been appointed for the designing and planning.
- Landscape screening options explained *Option 1*. Is a one off payment to plant tress themselves. *Option 2*. Trees planted and maintained for two years by a local contractor.

BERRYBANK 2 UPDATE

- The three month service has been completed, including the transformer.
- AEMO wanted some additional tests, delaying the handover process by another week.
- Provisional acceptance sent to Vestas BB2 "100% under Operation."
- 26 Turbines in full production
- Landowners will be contacted in coming weeks to fully execute their Deeds.
- Berrybank-Walliduc Rd maintenance has been completed.

Corangamite Shire Council Update

Berrybank Wind Farm Grants | Round 2

Interest in this year's second round of Berrybank Wind Farm Grants was even stronger compared to the inaugural round in 2022. There were 28 applications in all requesting a total of \$466,343 to support beneficial community projects within 75 kilometres of the Berrybank development.

Under the Voluntary Agreement the Annual Monetary Contribution for 2022 was \$52,500, and Council decided not to exceed this budget and further add to the deficit it is carrying forward from 2022. That meant that only four project applications were able to be funded in 2023, namely:

• Derrinallum Recreation Reserve Committee of Management

Netball court upgrade \$20,000

• Derrinallum Bowling Club

Painting of Bowls Clubrooms \$12,000

Noorat A & P Society

Enclose and clad the Homecrafts Annex \$10,000

• Lismore Land Protection Group

Restoring connectivity and on-farm biodiversity \$9,995

Berrybank Wind Farm Grants | Round 1 (2022)

Four of the six projects funded through Round 1 have now been completed.

- Installation of basketball half-court at the Skipton Swimming Pool
- Improving ecological connectivity through revegetation around Lismore
- Restoration of the Thomas Seymour memorial gates at the Lismore Rec Reserve
- Construction of ramps, handrails and shelter at the Lismore Mens Shed.
- Cressy Water Tower Public Art project is expected to be completed in October 2023.
- **Restumping the Darlington Hall** The quoted cost has increased by \$20,000 over the original estimate. The Hall Committee is looking to secure additional funding and to engage the contractor.

Community Benefit Deed

There is little to report on the finalisation of outstanding projects supported through the CommunityBenefit Deed. Eleven of the 15 projects have been completed, with 3 more close to being finalised.

• Darlington hall roof replacement

Installation of run-off French drain pending (\$5,000). Waiting on plumber.

• Glenormiston South Hall upgrade

Exterior painting and gravel to be laid (no report on progress).

• Bradvale Hall upgrade

Project completed, but plumber certification of septic system yet to be supplied.

• Derrinallum Change Rooms

Work is progressing on first stages of this \$300,000 project after delays in securing a builder (and afterthe first appointed builder pulled out). Project has been broken up into smaller stages, to be tackled progressively by the Committee of Management. Corangamite Works staff are providing guidance.

Larger local projects

Community members are being supported to develop some larger high-impact local projects for whichBerrybank Wind Farm funding support will/ may be sought. These include:

Derrinallum Skate Park at the Derrinallum Rec Reserve

Design specification and cost estimates completed by CONVIC, supported by local donations and a Corangamite Shire Enabling Grant.

Browns Water Holes footbridge replacement

Structural engineer has inspected – yet to provide quote for development of design specification forwooden replacement footbridge.

Berrybank School renovation

GPG/ BBWF arranging for a building assessment as part of preparations for scoping assessment.

Golden Plains Shire Report:

Berrybank Windfarm Community Grants.

Applications now selected for the Berrybank Windfarm Community Grants in the following two categories:

- Economic Development, Tourism Projects and Events
- Community Projects and Events over \$10,000, with one off and recurring funding available.
 - There was no application from Walliduc Community submitted.
 - The topic of the mower was raised.
 - Phil explained that proximity to the wind farm is highly regarded in the selection process, but this was not possible as there were no applications from the immediate area.
 - We spoke about the need to organise some kind of sessions with local groups to encourage/help them to apply.

7 of the 14 applicants were awarded, Peter informed of all the projects awarded.

• Peter reported that the Council were using the funds as leverage for a Federal funding application.
